General Membership Meeting April 3rd, 2024, at The Greentree Inn

Regional Executive Jim Locke convened the meeting at 7:30 PM.

A motion (Terrill/Matenkosky) to approve the minutes of the February meeting as published passed 7-0-0.

We have two new members present this evening. They literally joined today! They are Eric and Kris Thorniley from Irwin. Welcome!

TREASURER: Gene Kern

We started the month with \$93,561.22 and ended with \$11,983.64 for a gain of \$18,422.42. Our obligations are \$114,882.50.

MEMBERSHIP: Paula Locke via ZOOM

Current member count from the Galley report is 737. We had 14 new members and 11 weekend members.

Ashley asked about the interests of the new members, and Paula said she would check. One showed an interest in Solo and one in Trials.

TRACK TRIALS/HILL CLIMB: Rick Terrill for Dan Dennehy

We have 27 registrations for the April event. There was a question about transponders that was not resolved.

SOLO: Joe Montuoro

We had 63 drivers at the March event because it was a nice day. April 13th is a school - 24 people and 6 to 7 instructors, 6 of whom are National champs! April 20 Test & Tune - we expect 62 or so entries. April 27th is the first event, held with the Majors. Event #2 is May 11, and #3 is May18th

RALLY: Don Baker

April 14th is a Blue Ridge event somewhere North of Pittsburgh at 1PM. Don will get details for the BOD, but thinks it starts from the Sarver Rails-to-Trails lot.

ROAD RACING REPORT: Bob Albert/Gene Kern

The Majors is scheduled for PittRace April 26 - 28. Break even car count is approximately 120 for the Race and 44 for the test day. Test day schedule will be finalized a week before the event based on entries. There is a group on Friday for HPDE/ Time trials cars. Currently we have no entries. If we don't have at least 7, this group will be cancelled. Undersubscribed Friday race groups may be combined.

I will update the number of entries immediately prior to the meeting Wednesday.

There are some upcoming potentially large expenditures that will be required. These include repairs to the region trailers and the purchase of scales and ramps to alleviate some ongoing issues. Those expenditures will stretch or even deplete our treasury. We cannot continue to depend on entry fees and memberships to finance our programs into the future. The region needs soon to develop other sources of revenue. This may include such things as sponsorship, donations, selling tickets, 50/50 raffles at events,

and I'm only partially kidding, bake sales. Anybody have any ideas and is willing to quickly drive this forward? For sponsorship we need to modernize and integrate our websites and messaging to be able to offer sponsors something in return. The status quo will not suffice if we are to survive and grow long term.

Getting sponsorship should involve an all program effort with revenue sharing across the programs.

Gene added that there are 53 entries so far, and that we are short in specialties and that he will set up a ZOOM meeting for the Chiefs.

OLD BUSINESS:

Spread the word that we will have laps for charity Saturday and Sunday. Invite other clubs to collect for their own charities, we will collect for the Butler Humane Society. Gene asked Paula to contact John Walko Sr.
